Install Theme

Before installing Danni theme, you have to install WordPress. To install WordPress, please check this codex page: https://codex.wordpress.org/Installing_WordPress

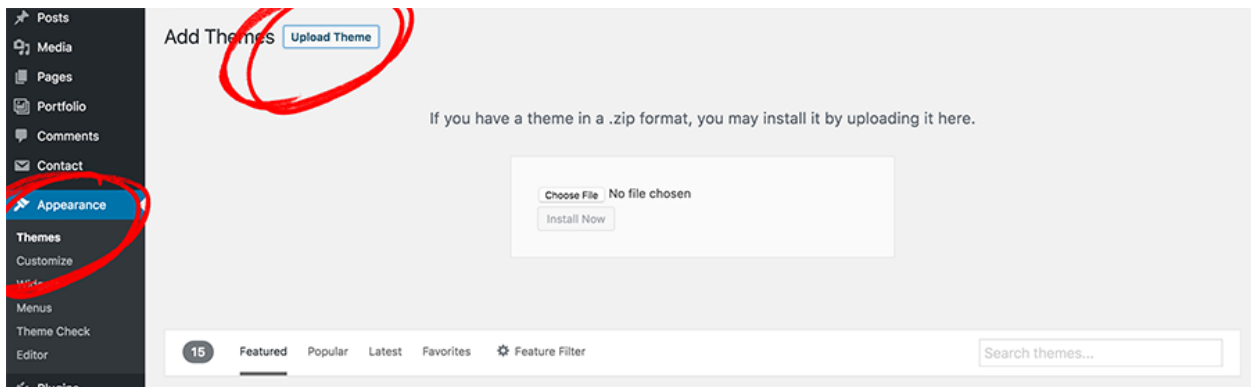
There's two ways installing Danni theme. If you got stylesheet missing issue during installing process, please check [this article](#).

Method 1: Install Danni Theme from WP backend.

We suppose that you've logged into your WP backend.

Step 1: Go to Dashboard > Appearance > Themes

Step 2: Click "Add New" then click "Upload Theme"



Step 3: Upload **danni.zip** file then click "Activate". Note that, if you download package was **Danni Full.zip**, you need to unzip this package to get **danni.zip** file. That's the actual theme file.

Step 4: Go to **Appearance > Install Plugins** to install necessary plugins. Note that you have to install [Jetpack Plugin](#) to use Gallery Format.

Method 2: Install Danni Theme via FTP.

We suppose that you have knowledge about FTP. File Zilla is a free FTP software you can [learn more about it here](#).

Step 1: Unzip your download package from ThemeForest. If you don't see a folder "danni", please continue to unzip file "danni.zip", you'll get a folder naming "danni".

Step 2: Upload folder *danni* to `ROOT_FOLDER/wp-content/themes/` directory on your server and wait for uploading process completed.

Step 3: Go to *Dashboard > Appearance > Themes*, you'll see Danni theme there. Click activate the theme.

Step 4: Go to *Appearance > Install Plugins* to install necessary plugins.

Common Installing Issues

Quick Setup (same as demo)

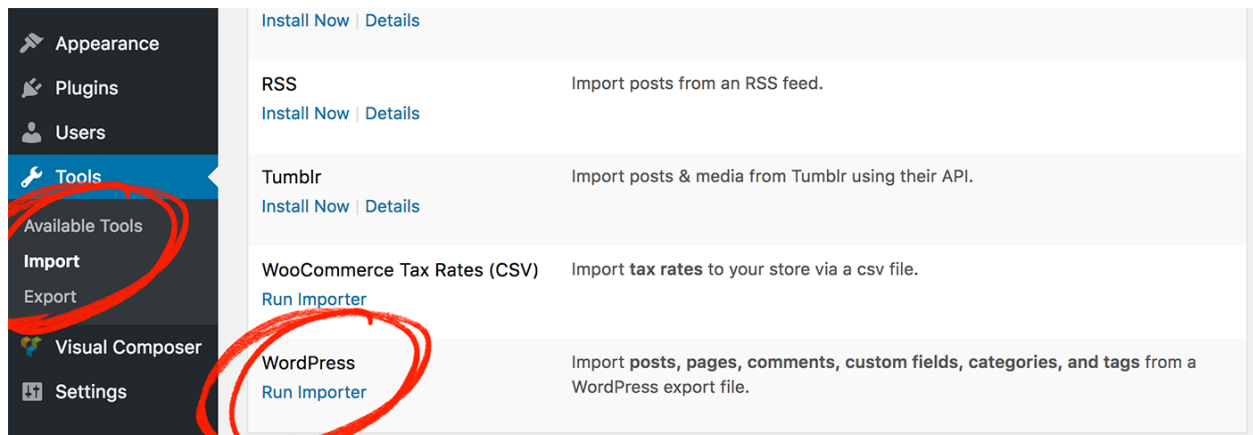
Step 1: Install Danni theme. If you've done, move to step 2.

Step 2: Install all required plugins in **Dashboard > Appearance > Install Plugins**. Danni supports few plugins so you can use them with Danni after installing.

Note that (Danni) Addons is the plugin allows you to display social share icons after each single post. It includes also two widgets: Post List and Social Profiles.

Step 3: Go to **Dashboard > Tools > Import** and click to “WordPress” link (the last option) to install WordPress Importer.



Step 4: Click to “Run Importer” and upload **demo.xml** file from your download package. Then click to “Upload and run importer”. Check to “Download and import file attachments”. Wait until the imported completed the importing process. It takes about 2 minutes – 15 minutes depending on your server connection.

Do not forget to check to “*Download and import file attachments*”

Import WordPress

Assign Authors

To make it easier for you to edit and save the imported content, you may want to reassign the author entries as `admin` s entries.

If a new user is created by WordPress, a new password will be randomly generated and the new user

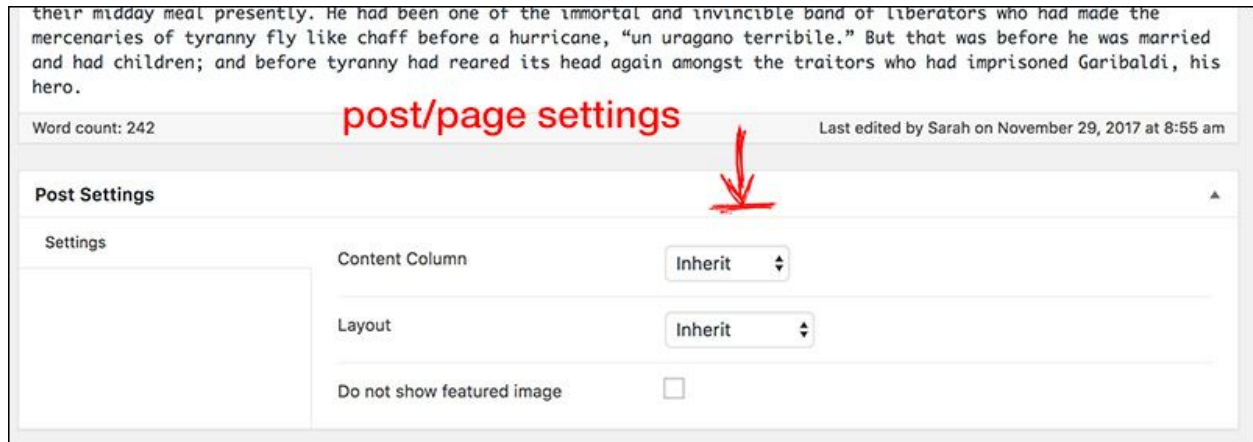
Step 5: Go to *Dashboard > Appearance > Menus* to setup menu locations. Please assign menus to right positions:

- Primary -> Primary Menu
- Social -> Header Social
- Footer Nav -> Footer Menu

Step 6: Go to *Dashboard > Appearance > Widgets* to setup your footer widgets yourself and *Dashboard > Appearance > Customize* to customize the site's look.

Post & Page Options

Below each post and page editor in your backend, there're few options for you to customize post/page layout.



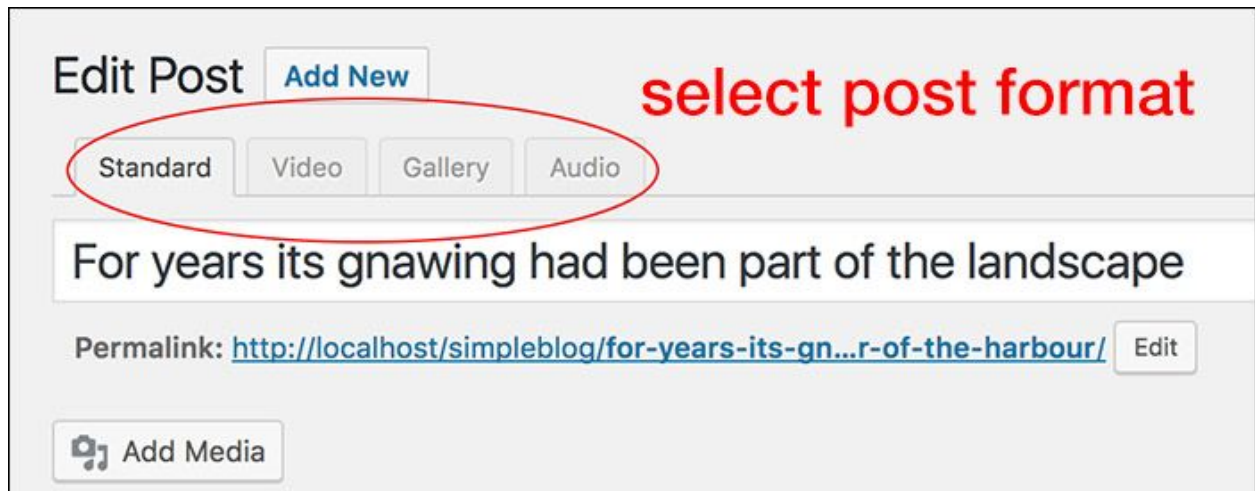
Content Column: You can enable 2-column layout for your article like [this example](#)

Layout: You can set sidebar on the left, right, fullwidth. If you select "Inherit", it takes default value in *Customize > Single*

Do not show featured image: This option for disabling featured image on single posts.

Post Formats

Danni supports following post formats: standard, video, audio, gallery.



Standard: You need to do nothing. It's standard post format by default.

Video: You're allowed to add YouTube, Vimeo urls. Note that you should enter urls like this:

`https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=3AtDnEC4zak`

Do not enter iframe or any embed code. If your post doesn't have a featured image, Danni automatically pulls a featured image from your video.

Audio: Danni supports some audio services such as Soundcloud, Spotify.. You need to enter urls like this:

`https://soundcloud.com/majorlazer/major-lazer-light-it-up-feat-nyla-fuse-odgremix`

Gallery: Gallery post format requires [Jetpack plugin](#) to work so you have to install Jetpack first then connect to a WordPress.com account so that you can use Jetpack features.

After that, go to **Jetpack > Settings** and enable features below:

Setup Blog/Homepage

Your blog is automatically set up after installing the theme. However you can go to *Dashboard > Appearance > Customize > Blog* to setup blog layout, style... for your blog.

Danni offers 3 layouts:

1. [Standard Post Layout](#) same as demo
2. [List layout](#)
3. [Grid layout](#)

Each layout can be used with sidebar or not. Sidebar can be also set on the left or right.

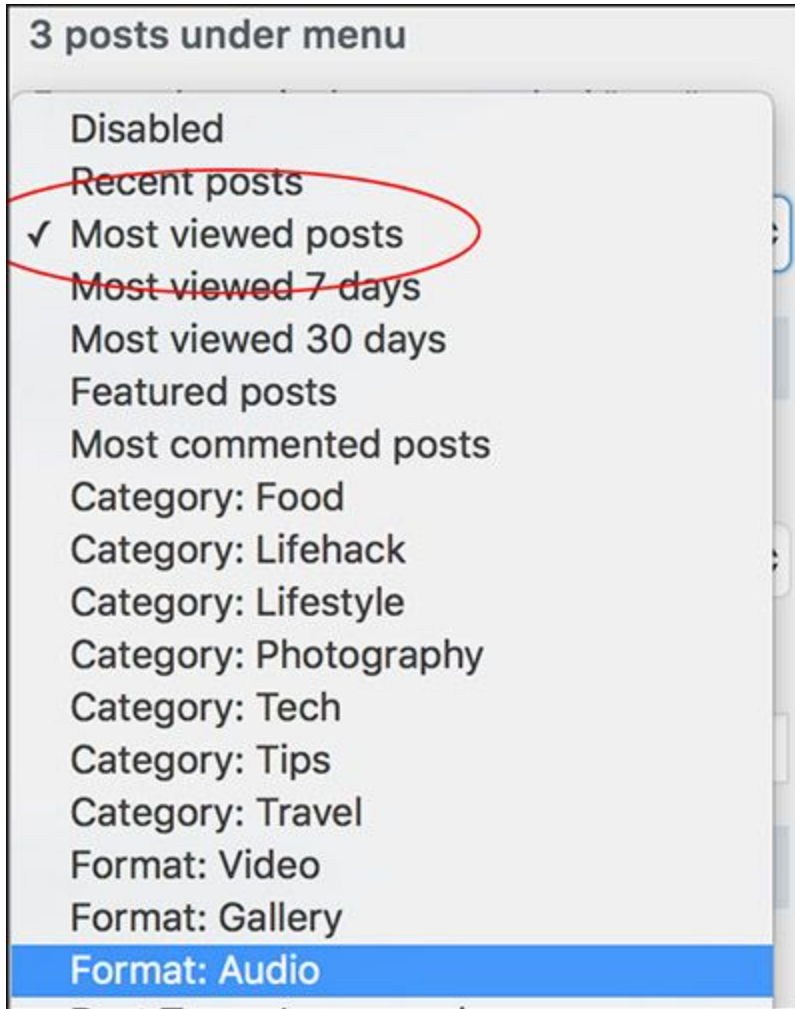
Number of posts to show: You can go to *Dashboard > Settings > Reading* to set the number of posts you wanna display in your blog

Three posts below the navigation bar

In *Customize > Homepage*, there's an option to display 3 posts below your navigation bar as below picture:

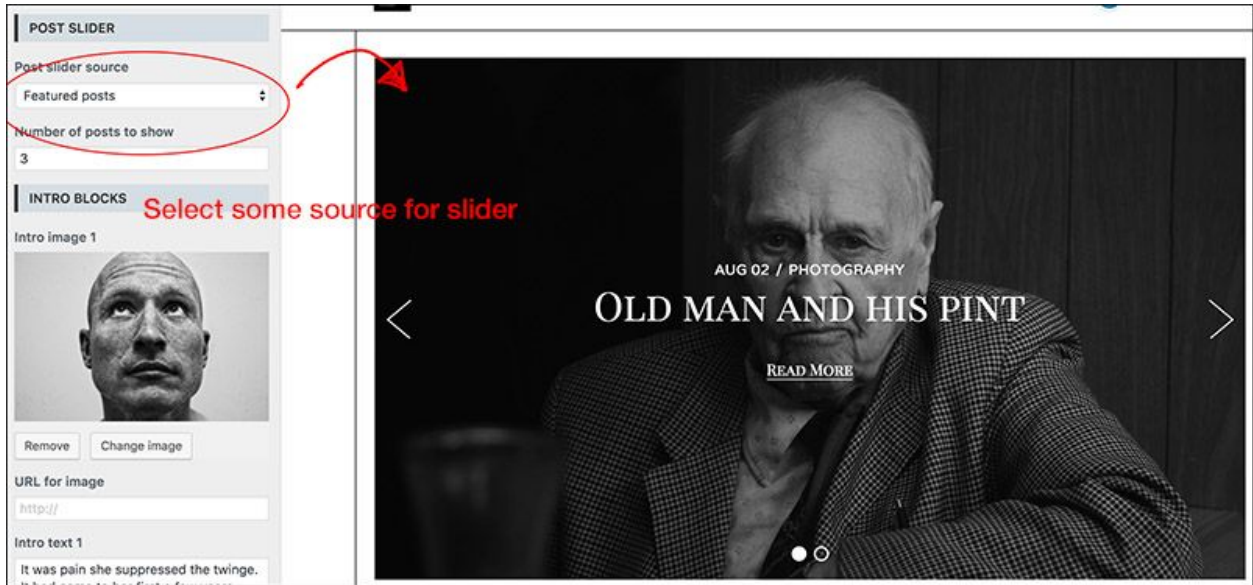


There're many sources of posts to display but on the demo, we displayed "Most viewed posts". It'll show posts with highest view counts (by some internal counter system of the theme)



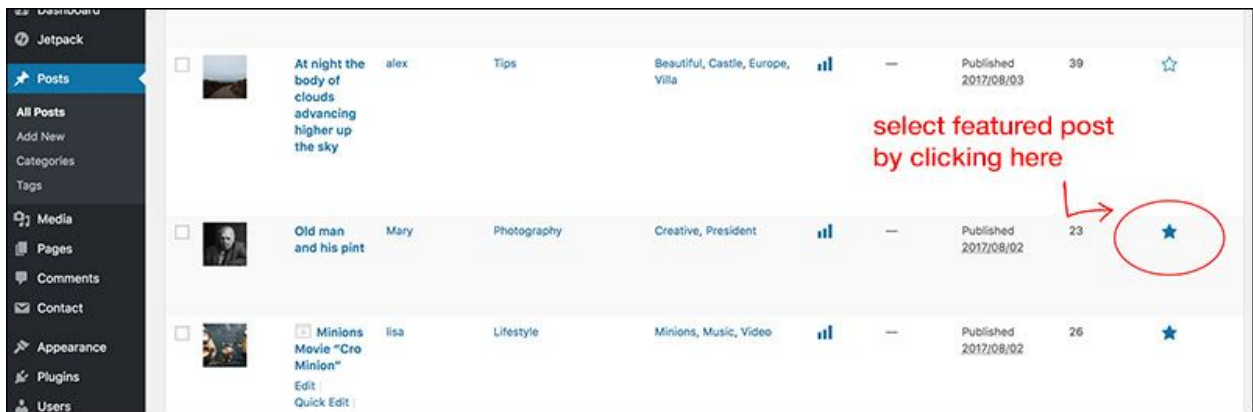
Post Slider

Post Slider is the element described as below




Featured posts are posts marked “star” in *Dashboard > Posts*

Setup Social Profiles

Go to *Dashboard > Menus* to setup Facebook, Twitter, Pinterest... urls. Please just create a menu with your social profiles then assign it to “Header Social” position, theme will automatically render them to icons.

Setup Contact Page with Contact Form 7

Danni supports [Contact Form 7](#) plugin. This is the most popular free contact form. It's really easy to work with.

Step 1: Install [Contact Form 7](#) plugin. We assume that you have basic knowledge about how to install a plugin.

Step 2: Go to **Dashboard > Contact > Add New** to create a new form like this:

```
<label>[text* your-name placeholder "Your Name*"]</label>
```

```
<label>[email* your-email placeholder "Your Email*"] </label>
```

```
<label>[text your-subject placeholder "Your Subject"] </label>
```

```
<label>[textarea your-message placeholder "Your Message"] </label>
```

```
[submit "Send"]
```

Note that this form is different from your default one because we use placeholders instead of labels.

Site Style & Typography

Theme styling includes accent color, text color, background...

Typograpy includes setting up body font, heading font and their sizes.

These options are quite obvious and you can setup easily at *Dashboard > Customize > Style* and *Dashboard > Customize > Typography*

Translate your theme

Danni includes **danni.pot** file in `/wp-content/themes/danni/languages/` directory. Open it with some Translation software, say POEdit. Translate all words you need and save 2 files `*po` and `*mo` as suitable names. For example, if you want to translate to Germany, save your files as `de_DE.po` and `de_DE.mo`. See [Installing WordPress In Your Language](#) for more details about file name.

Open file `wp-config.php` in your WordPress root folder and looking for the line **`define('WPLANG', ''`**); Replace `''` by the language you want. See [Installing WordPress in Your Language](#) for more details.

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Example: If your language you want to translate was French. Following these steps:

Step 1: Open file `wp-config.php` in your WordPress root folder. You need FTP Software or some file manager to do this.

Step 2: Look for the line **`define('WPLANG', ''`**); and rewrite as **`define('WPLANG', 'fr_FR'`**); If your language is German, It should be **`define('WPLANG', 'de_DE'`**);

Step 3: In to your theme, rename `danni.pot` to `fr_FR.pot`

Step 4: Open `fr_FR.pot` with POEdit and start editing, then save files as `fr_FR.po` and `fr_FR.mo` in the same folder `danni/languages`.
